



If you were following along with MickeyBlog you'll know that Disney has taken some time over the COVID-19 shutdown to give their policies a bit of a rethink when it comes to everything from annual passes to dress codes. With that in mind, Disney has recently updated their dress code polices and for the first time small tattoos are now permissible as well as other changes including gender-inclusive hairstyles, jewelry, nail styles and costume choices. We've seen what some of these changes consist of and are excited to share them with you! Cast members will be allowed to wear head coverings for religious purposes. However, they must be solid black, white or a color that coordinates with cast member uniforms. The shaving of lines or shapes in facial hair is now permitted provided that facial hair is well maintained and the designs are not offensive in any way. Nail polish can be worn but the color must be the same across all fingers. Decals or charms are not permitted provided that facial hair is well maintained and the designs are not offensive in any way. be in natural and neutral colors. Hair accessories can be worn like headbands, bows and hair-ties but they must be in neutral colors and match the cast member's uniform. As you can see from the image above, tattoos cannot be any larger than a cast member's uniform. be placed on the head, face or neck. Tattoo sleeves to conceal larger tattoos are permitted. Tattoos with offensive imagery or nudity will not be accepted. Any piercings other than ears are not permitted. Tattoos are permitted. cannot be longer than 2 inches. We're glad to see Disney's cast member policies get a bit of an upgrade. We've merely skimmed the surface of some of the changes you may see in the months ahead. In addition, Disney advised in a release earlier today that they are also looking to update other policies including the ways that cast members show up for work. The aim is to provide greater flexibility when it comes to personal expressive, gender-inclusivity, hairstyles, jewelry, nail styles and costume choices. Disney said , "We're updating them to not only remain relevant in today's workplace, but also enable our cast members to better express their cultures and individuality at work. On Tuesday, Josh D'Amaro, Chairman of Disney Parks, Experiences and Products, announced in a blog post on the company's website that a new initiative will allow employees (which they refer to as "cast members") greater flexibility when it comes to their costumes, hairstyles and more. + Follow "It's important to me to share how we're creating a place where everyone is welcome and taking action to create meaningful change," D'Amaro wrote. "Our new approach provides greater flexibility with respect to forms of personal expression surrounding gender-inclusive hairstyles, jewelry, nail styles, and costume choices; and allowing appropriate visible tattoos. We're updating them to not only remain relevant in today's workplace, but also enable our cast members to better express their cultures and individuality at work." The blog post went on to share that Disney listened to employee reviews and suggestions by adding a fifth pillar to its "four keys" (safety, courtesy, show and efficiency). D'Amaro explained that "when we asked our cast how we could better cultivate a culture of belonging, they suggested the addition of a fifth key: the key of Inclusion." "Like The Four Keys before them, The 5 Keys - with Inclusion at the heart - will continue to guide us as we interact with guests, collaborate together, create the next generation of Disney products and experiences, and make critical decisions about the future of our business," he continued. "Inclusion is essential to our culture and leads us forward as we continue to realize our rich legacy of engaging storytelling, exceptional service, and Disney magic." D'Amaro explained that they "want our guests to see their own backgrounds and traditions reflected in the stories, experiences and products they encounter in their interactions with Disney." And that extends to employees as well. "And we want our cast members - to feel a sense of belonging at work." The post concluded with D'Amaro acknowledging that "the world is changing" and Disney parks is committed to "change with it." He said the company believes that cast members — "who are at the center of the magic that lives in all [Disney] experiences" — will do their best work when they have the freedom to express themselves. "There's more to do, but we're committed to listening, learning and making meaningful improvements." "We'll never stop working to make sure that Disney is a welcoming place for all. I'm excited about where we're headed, and we'll have more to share soon," he wrote. "Thank you for joining us on this journey." ANAHEIM, Calif. Recently, Disney announced that it would be adding the fifth key of Inclusion to its set of standards in order to have a diverse team with open opportunities. As a part of that new guest service criterion, Disney will also be giving Cast Members identify and personally express themselves. This means that gender-inclusive hairstyles, jewelry, nail styles, costume choices, and appropriate visible tattoos will be a part of the permitted policies for those at work. © Disney finds it important for Cast Members to express their cultures in individuality at all times, while also modernizing its workplace. Since the Cast Members really are the heart of the parks and the company, this update will allow for more personal and engaging experiences for both employees and quests moving forward. Cast Members at Disney's Old Key West Resort According to the official Disney Look Book, tattoos are not permitted on the face, head, or neck without being larger than the Cast Member's hand when fully extended with the fingers held together. They must not depict nudity, offensive or inappropriate language or images, or violate Company policies. Nails shouldn't exceed one-fourth of an inch beyond the fingertip. Hairstyles must be well-maintained with length or completely shaved styling at the Cast Member's discretion. Longer hair below should be secured if it falls forward over the face or covers the name tag. Natural hair colors are only permitted, but lined and shapes shaved into the hair are permitted as long as they don't have offensive words or symbols. Various jewelry is allowed as long as it doesn't distract from overall appearances. These include bracelets, watches, necklaces, earrings, rings, and more are permitted with certain guidelines.
